2. Completed Forest Sink Plan (refer to plan template available from MAF).	
3. Map showing boundaries of the landholding and the Forest Sink Area including road access to the forest.	
4. Recent search copy of computer freehold register (certificate of title(s)) showing the current owners and/or Māori Land Court titles.	
5. Copy of a registered forestry right or lease (if applicable).	
6. Copy of Māori Trust order (if applicable).	
7. For areas greater than 50 ha a geospatial data file derived from an orthographically corrected aerial photograph or a survey plan capable of being deposited under the Land Transfer Act that verifies the boundaries of the Forest Sink Area ¹ .	
8. For areas less than 50 ha either a data file as above OR GPS coordinates of the boundary of the Forest Sink Area ¹ .	
9. Evidence of land eligibility to enter the PFSI – i.e. the land must be Kyoto compliant land (land not covered by an eligible forest on midnight 31 December 1989). Suitable evidence may include aerial photographs and oblique photographs of the property taken at or around 1990 and farm records which demonstrate the use of the land as at 31 December 1989.	
10. Application Fee: Cheque enclosed for NZ\$562.50 or EFT unique reference identifier entered above.	

¹ The data file or GPS information supplied must identify the coordinate system used. MAF's preference is to use the NZ Transverse Mercator projection.
